


PDSA | Plan - Do - Study - Act

Objective for this PDSA Cycle:

- Develop a change idea
- Test a change idea
- Implement a change idea



What question(s) do we want to answer with this PDSA cycle?

PLAN | answer who, what, where, when

1) I plan to (who, what, where, when):

2) Data collection (who, what, where, when):

Refer to the data collection plan.

3) I hope this produces (predictions):

4) Steps to execute:

List tasks necessary to complete the test, who is responsible, and when it is due.

DO | report what happened (data); begin analysis

What did we observe?

STUDY | complete analysis of data; compare data to predictions and summarize

What did we learn? Did we meet our measurement goal?

ACT | determine if you are ready to make a change (adopt, adapt, abandon)

What did we conclude from this cycle?

Decide to adopt, adapt, or abandon the idea:

Adopt: Select changes to implement the idea on a larger scale.

Adapt: Improve the change and continue testing.

Abandon: Discard the idea and try something different.
